Nest Notes:

2004 Ospreys first found nesting 19th May. Two chicks hatched, but both were killed 30th June when the nest was blown down in a gale.

2005 A female Osprey was present at the nest site for one week from 4th to 11th April, not believed to be the regular female.

2006 Eldest chick dies in the nest at lunchtime 30th June. Ejected from nest by female 3rd July, remains recovered - unable to establish cause of death.

2007 One chick, (believed to be middle chick), dies in the nest 3rd June 11:45, reason unknown. Body ejected from nest by female, but not recovered.

2011 The first egg and first chick are confirmed the earliest UK records by Roy Dennis.

2012 It is believed the female returned on the evening of 19th March, although she was not positively identified until the following morning at 09:20.

2012 First egg confirmed 10:02am 4th April. Believed to have been laid late evening 3rd, (female remained low in the nest during a storm).

2012 Nest cup was very high and three eggs were not visible until 2.45pm 11th April.
